En gules, una cruz, de oro, cargada de cinco lobos, de sable, pasantes. En punta, de plata dos ondas, de azur. Bordura general de oro, con ocho aspás, de gules.

Principal Title : Duke of Almodóvar del Río.

Creation : Spain, 1780

Subsidiary Titles : Viscount of Manzanera (1857), Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : Hoyos y Martel de Irujo.

Family History : The roots of this distinction go back to the XV Century. The title of duke was granted, in 1780, in favour of don Pedro Francisco de Lujan y Gongora, Marquis de Almodovar del Rio and of Ontiveros, Count de Canalejas. In 1814, it passed into the hands of the Córdoba family, one of the most eminent in Spain and in whose favour one of the original Grandees was appointed. From there, it passed into the Sanchez family and then into that of Hoyos.
