### *Description of Arms :*

En campo de plata, una banda, de sable y unas cadenas, de sable, puestas en orla.

**Principal Title :** Duke of Arión.

**Creation :** Spain, 1725.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Duke of Cánovas del Castillo (1901), Marquis of Mancera (1623), of Malpica (1599) and of Valero (1636), Grandee of Spain.

**Family Name :** Fernández de Córdova y Larios.

**Family History :** With this title, we go back to the royal house of Navarre, the Zuñiga Counts of Ledesma and Dukes of Béjar. It was originally created in favour of don Baltassar de Zuñiga y Guzman, Marquis de Alenquer etc, who was Vice-Roy of Navarre and of Sardinia. The dukedom then passed through several hands, following Spanish custom. First, it visited the House of Pimental, then Counts of Benevente; in 1764, it went on to the Velasco family, Counts of Penaranda ; then to the Tellez-Giron, Marquises of Villena and Dukes of Escalona. A mere seventeen years later, it was in the possession of Cordova, Marquis de Malpica.
