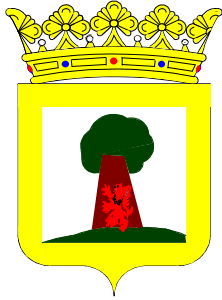


Bailen



Description of Arms :

En campo de plata, un arbol, de sinople, terrasado de lo mismo, con un leon parado, de gules, atravesado al tronco. Bordura de oro.

Principal Title : Duke of Bailen.

Creation : Spain, 1833.

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : Caverio de Carondelet y Bally.

Family History : Originally, the title of Duke of Bailen was granted to don Francisco Javier deCastanos y Aragorri, Marquis de Pontugalete. With it was also conferred the rank of Grandee of Spain. Don Francsco was Captain-General of the royal troops and ganed a famous victory against the soldiers of Napoleon at Bailen.

At first the style was a life duchy and the holder died without posterity. However, he was succeeded by his nephew, don Luis Angel de Carondelet y Castanos and the title was made hereditary, in 1847, by Queen Isabella II.

In 1883, the duchy passed into the House of Cordoba, Duke of Arion and Marquis of Malpica.
