


Beauvau-Craon

Principal Title : Prince de Beauvau-Craon.

Creation : Holy Roman Empire (primogeniture, 1722).

Subsidiary Titles : Marquis de Beauvau (1664), Marquis de Craon (1712), Grandee 1st Class (1727), Prince de Beauvau-Craon (1755), Count of the French Empire (1810). *Cousin du Roi* (1711), Prince of the Holy Roman Empire (1722).

Family Name : Beauvau-Craon.

Family History : This old noble family traces its origins to Anjou. Descent can be proved, since 1265, to René, who was *seigneur* of Beauvau. Following a marriage, in 1370, they added the name of Craon.

In 1712, came the rank of Marquis and the style of “cousins of the King”. This was followed, in 1722, with the rank of *Reichfürst von Beauvau-Craon*. They then became Grandees of Spain in 1727.

Long one of the post prominent families in Lorraine, the daughters still possess what is probably the most impressive château in that region. The last Prince died in 1982.
