Principal Title : Duke de Bournonville.

Creation : As Prince (1658) in Flanders. Duke (1717).

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : Silva y Mora

Family History : Don Miguel de Bournonville y Sainte-Alegonde was created a prince in Flanders. This was when Spain still ruled over the Low Countries. However, this is evidently a Spanish family and in due course, 1717, the title was exchanged for that of duke - with the added honour of being included in the ranks of Grandees.
