


## Calvaruso



### *Description of Arms :*

D'azzurro alla cometa d'oro posta in sbarra nel canton sinistro del capo ed al triangolo d'oro posto in sbarra nel canton destro della punta. Lo scudo accollato all'aquila di nero, coronata e membrata d'oro, linguata ed armata di rosso.

**Principal Title :** Prince of Calvaruso.

**Creation :** Italy, 1912.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Baron of Mandrascate (1755), Baron of Azzolino (1761), Baron of Gallizzi (1919).

**Family Name :** Trigona.

**Family History :** With this family, we are dealing with another of those Sicilian clans that have been established for a very long time - in this case since the XIII Century. And as with so many others, it has split into several branches.

This is the senior line of the Trigona family. In 1755, they received the barony of Mandrascate, on the basis of male primogeniture. Six years later came the title of Baron of Azzolino and then that of Baron of Gallizzi - both on the same basis.

In 1912, the head of this line was raised to the rank of Prince di Calvaruso.

1st Branch : Prince of Calvaruso (1912), Baron of Mandrascate (1755), Baron of Azzolino (1761), Baron of Gallizzi (1919).

2nd Branch : Marquis of Canicarao (XVIIIth), Marquis of Dainammare (1662), Baron of Frigintini (1739), Baron of Salina or Mantano del Roverta (1742), Sire of Bauli, Ursitto, Grampoli with Stafenda, Imbaccari and Misilini (1739).

3rd Branch : Duke of Misterbianco (1685), Duke of Sinagra (1808)

4th Branch : Marquis of Floresta (1773), Baron of San Cono (1662), Baron of Scitibillini (1794), Baron of San Antonio (1794)
