**Principal Title :** Duke of Castro-Terreno

**Creation :** Spain, 1825

**Subsidiary Titles :** Count of Ezpeleta of Veire (1797), Grandee of Spain, Marquis of Montehermoso (1714) and Count of Echauz (1784) and of Triviana (1613).

**Family Name :** Sancho-Navarro y Villar-Villamil

**Family History :** The source of this family goes back to the XI Century. By 1782, they had become Counts of Castro-Terreno. In 1825, Count don Prudencio de Guadalajara y Aguilera was made a duke - keeping the same name.
