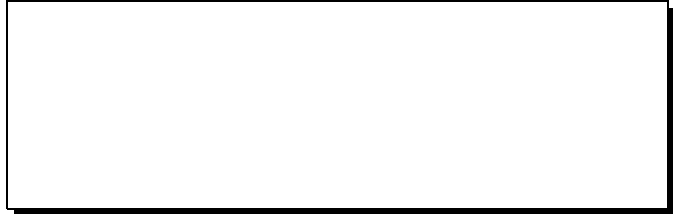


Clary und Aldringen

Description of Arms :



Principal Title : H.S.H. Prince von Clary und Aldringen.

Creation : Prince in Bohemia, Vienna (1767).

Subsidiary Titles : Baron and Count in Bohemia, Princely Count of the Holy Roman Empire.

Family Name : Clary und Aldringen.

Family History : Originally from Frioul, where a citation exists from 1363, the Clary family was established in Bohemia by the year 1627. Ten years later, a marriage was contracted with the heiress of the Aldringen family and her name was added to that of her husband. In 1664, they became barons in Bohemia and then, in 1666, this was raised to the level of count - in the joint name. In 1680, they were accorded the honour of Count of the Holy Roman Empire. Nearly a century afterwards, a fresh honour, that of prince in Bohemia followed - with the style *Hochgeboren* or Highness. Finally, this was improved, in 1905, to the style of Serene Highness.
