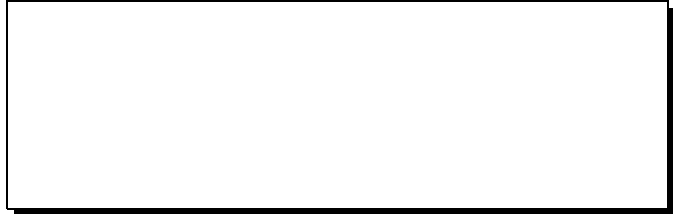


Ginori Conti

Principal Title : Prince and Count Ginori Conti.

Creation : Papal, 1835.

Subsidiary Titles : Prince of Trevignano.

Family Name : Ginori Conti

Family History : The Ginori family comes from Florence, where they were inscribed as partisans in 1752. It has split into two main lines, the junior, which carries the title of marquis is known as the Ginori Lisci.

The princely branch was honoured by Pope Gregory XVI in 1835. From his hands, they received the titles of Prince and Prince di Trevignano, on the basis of male primogeniture. In 1855, the head of the Ginori family married into that of Conti and, as a result, inherited the arms and all the titles of the Contis.
