Principal Title : Prince Guasco Gallarati.

Creation : Holy Roman Empire, 1645.

Subsidiary Titles : Marquis of Francavilla (1679), Count of Frascaro (1674), etc ...

Family Name : Guasco Gallarati.

Family History : This old feudal family comes from Lombardy. It received the rank of *consignore* di Belmonte as long ago as 1168. The Lordship of Alice came from the Emperor Frederick II, in 1232. Other titles came, including that of Marquis di Bisio, 1474, and Marquis di Solero, 1637.

In 1644, a marriage took place with Princess Henriette de Lorraine and, as a result of this, the Guasco family acquired the right to carry the arms of Lorraine. This right has since fallen into disuetude. However, in 1517, a cardinal was chosen from the family and, since 1566, the right to display the coat of arms of the Holy See has applied.

In 1645, came the senior rank of Prince of the Holy Roman Empire, with the qualification of Serene Highness. In 1724, as a result of a marriage, the name of Gallarati was conjoined to that of Guasco. The right to the address *don* and *donna* was awarded in 1934.
