**Family History :** This was originally a Tartar family and is descended from the legendary Genghis Khan, Temudjin of the Mongols, who died in 1227. Genghis, himself, was the ninth generation in succession to Budantsar, a Mongol chief who flourished in the IX Century - which is a long time ago.

When the great Khan divided his empire, his grandson, Toka Timur, recieved the realm of Grand Bulgaria. His descendant ( the 6th generation ) was called Tash Timur and he conquered the Crimea and there founded a khanate which lasted from 1420 to 1783. It is from this source that the Princes Guireÿ come.

When the area came under Russian control, they were recognised as foreign nobles, first of all, and then as foreigners with titles. From 1847, the Senate Directing Russian Affairs formally recognised the family as having the rank of prince. This was repeated on several occasions later on.
