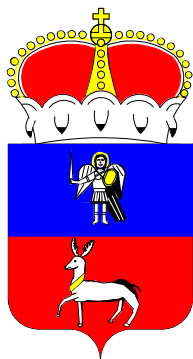


Kosatkin-Rostovsky **Loban-Rostovsky**



Description of Arms :

Per fess azure and gules, in chief Michael the Archangel vested argent, his dexter arm extended holding erect a sword of the last and on his sinister arm a shield Or, and in base a stag in full course of the third, collared gold.

Family Name : Kosatkin-Rostovsky, Kossatkine-Rostowsky.

Family History : This family is descended from the Princes of Rostov. The great-great-grandson of the Great Prince Vladimir Sviatoslavich, the Christianizer of Russia, Great Prince Vsevolod Yurievich, placed his son, Prince Konstantin, to rule in the Principality of Rostov. His son, Prince Vasilii, gave his son, Prince Boris, the Principality of Rostov as an apanage. The grandsons of Prince Boris, Prince Konstantin and Fedor Vasilievich, divided Rostov into two parts. Prince Konstantin Vasilievich, the Prince of Vladimir, had a great-grandson, Prince Mikhail Aleksandrovich Kosatkin, whose descendants, the Princes Kosatkin-Rostovsky, served the Russian Throne in distinguished positions and were granted fiefdoms by the Tsars for their service to the Fatherland and were given other tokens of honor and of the Monarch's favor.
