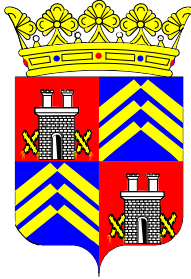


La Salle



Description of Arms :

Ecartelé : aux 1 et 4, de gueules à la tour d'argent donjonnée de 2 pièces maçonnées de sable soutenue de 2 troncs d'arbre écotés et déracinés d'or posés en sautoir, qui est de La Salle ; aux 2 et 3, d'azur à 3 chevrons brisés d'or, qui est de La Salle en Champagne.

Principal Title : Duke de la Salle.

Creation : Holy See, 1898. Title recognised in Spain, 1889

Subsidiary Titles :

Family Name : de la Salle de Rochemaure.

Family History : Extinct, 1921.

Anne-Louis-Hercule-Félix de la Salle became a Roman Duke in 1898. This was a reward for being the Bearer of the Cape and Sword of His Holiness. The title was then recognised, a year later in Spain, as Duke de la Salle de Rochemaure.

The first Duke had three sons. Two died, without issue, before their eldest brother, who should have succeeded. However, he was involved in a divorce and was so excluded. The title died out, with the second brother, in 1921.
