Principal Title : Duchess of Alba de Tormes.

Creation : Spain, 1707

Subsidiary Titles : Duke of Liria y Jerica, Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : del Rosario Cayetana Fitz James Stuart y Silva.

Family History : This title was created, in 1707, for Marshal don Jacobo (James) Fitz-James Stuart, together with the honour of Grandee (1st Class). He was also enrolled into the Knighthood of the Golden Fleece and that of the Garter.

The title has since passed into the possession of the Duchess of Alba de Tormes.
