Principal Title : Duke of Mandas and Villanueva.

Creation : Spain, 1614.

Subsidiary Titles : Marquis of Puebla de Parga (1680), Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : de la Huerta y Fernandez de Henestrosa.

Family History : This title was created, in 1614, in favour of don Pedro Maza y Carroz, Ladrón de Villanova y Mendoza who, until then, had been known under the title of Marquis de Terranova.

In 1884, the title was restored in favour of doña Maria Cristina Fernanda Brunetti y Gayoso de los Cobos. It fell vacant again, in 1979, with the death of doña Maria Rafaela Fernandez de Henestroa y Gayoso de los Cobos but has been taken on by don Ignacio de la Heurta y Fernandez de Henestrosa, her son, in 1982.
