


## Medina de Rioseco



### *Description of Arms :*

Escudo mantelado : 1° y 2°, en campo de gules, un castillo, de oro. Mantel de plata con un leon rampante, de gules.

**Principal Title :** Duchess of Medina de Rioseco.

**Creation :** Spain, 1538, re-established 1971.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Grandee of Spain.

**Family Name :** de Latorre y Tellez-Giron.

**Family History :** We go back, here, to the XIV century and to the House of Enríquez. This was a natural line from Alfonso XI of Castille. The original title was created in favour of don Fernando Enríquez y Velasco, Lord of Medina de Rioseco Count de Melgar and de Ruela. It is now in the possession of the Duchess of Osuna q.v.
