


## Decazes and Glücksbiere



*Description of Arms :*

D'argent à trois têtes de corbeaux arrachées de sable.

**Principal Title :** Duke Decazes and of Glücksbiere.

**Creation :** Decazes, France (1822). Glücksbiere, Denmark (1818).

**Subsidiary Titles :** Baron and Viscount.

**Family Name :** Decazes.

**Family History :** In the general scale of many French families, this must be considered quite modern, since it can only trace its existence back to the XIX century. Furthermore, the titles were awarded during the Restoration of the French Monarchy. However, it should be remembered that roughly half of the British peerage - usually considered the bench-mark - dates from the second half of the XIX Century.
