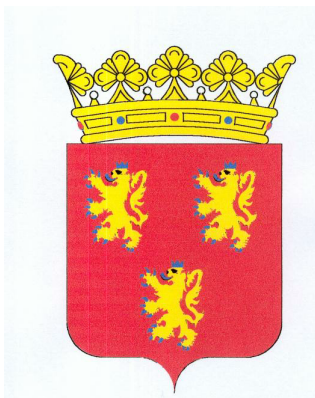


## Dino



### *Description of Arms :*

*For Talleyrand-Perigord : De gueules à 3 lions d'or armés, lampassés, couronnés d'azur.*

**Principal Title :** Duke of Dino.

**Creation :** Two Sicilies, 1815.

**Subsidiary Titles :**

**Family Name :** Gonzalez de Andia y Talleyrand-Périgord.

**Family History :** One of the greatest names in French history is that of Charles-Maurice de Talleyrand-Périgord. Probably descended from the Counts of Périgord, in 1155, the family had been represented on the Crusades. Always distinguished, it was Charles-Maurice who is in all the history books. He started life as a bishop, of Autun, at the age of thirty-four. That was in 1788. He was then condemned by the Pope and quitted the Church. He became close to Napoleon and was appointed Foreign Minister in 1797. In the turbulent changes from empire to monarchy, he was always able to pick the winning side and his great talents were widely appreciated.

Honours flowed : Count of the Empire (1810) ; Duke de Périgord (1817) ; Duke de Talleyrand (1817), de Sagan (1846), etc ... ; Duke de Sagan, in Silesia and so on. The one we are concerned with here is a dukedom - that of Dino - granted by the King of the Two Sicilies in 1815. Talleyrand had no sons and so most of his titles went to his brother. The dukedom of Dino went to his nephew. All, except this latter, have now died out.
