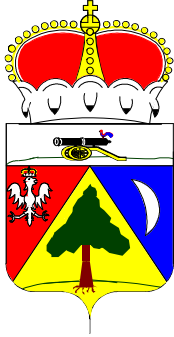


## Dmitriev



### *Description of Arms :*

Per pile transposed throughout : 1) gules, an eagle displayed its head tourne argent and ensigned with the coronet of a Russian Prince Argent ; 2) azure, a crescent moon in her increment argent ; 3) Or, on a mount a tree, proper. On a chief argent, on a mount a cannon, proper, mounted Or and perched on the sinister end of the chamber a bird of paradise of the field.

**Principal Title :** Prince Dmitriev.

**Creation :** Russia.

**Family Name :** Dmitriev.

**Family History :** Students of Russian history and coats-of-arms will recognise several features in the blason given above.

The Dmitriev family descend from the Princes of Smolensk and from Great Prince Vladimir Sviatoslavich, frequently quoted as the Christianiser of Russia. The family tree shows how many of these branches were connected and many appears under their various headings.
