Description of Arms :

Troncato : nel 1° d'argento al leone uscente d'azzurro accompagnato da sei plinti di rosso coricati posti in fascia ed ordinati in semicerchio ; nel 2° d'azzurro a tre stelle d'oro disposte 2 e 1.

Principal Title : Prince of Frasso and Dentice delle Stelle.

Creation : Naples, 1720.

Subsidiary Titles : Prince of San Vito (1626), Prince of Crucoli (1685), Count Dentice, Count of Santa Maria in Grisone.

Family Name : Dentice del Pesce.

Family History : This X Century family issues from Amalfi. Of feudal nobility, it was incribed as patricians of Sorrento and Naples and of the nobility of Salerno and Capua. It then split into two main branches - this and the Dentice delle Selle (see Accadia).

The Pesce line was honoured with the title of Prince di Frasso (male promogeniture) in 1720. However, as so often seems to have occurred in Italian families, it had accrued other titles, as a result of marriage. On this occasion, the Dentice family married the heiress of the Belprato Marchese family and, through this, acquired the titles of Prince of San Vito and prince of Crucoli. The former had been created in 1626, the latter in 1685, both on the basis of male promogeniture.
