Description of Arms :

Azure, issuant from the sinister edge a demi-Pegasus in full career argent, invelliped proper, and between its outstretched forelegs seven mullets of 6 points diversely arranged Or.

Principal Title : Prince Glebov.

Family History : 1 - : This family is descended from the honorable man named Oblaginia who in 1375 departed from France to serve the Great Prince Dmitrii Ioannovich Donskov. From him are descended the following families : Lodyzhensky, Adodurov, Novosiltov, Chepchugov, and Glebov, and many others. His great-great-grandson Gavril Savostianovich had a great-grandson, Gleb Ivanovich, and from him are descended the Glebov family who served the Throne as Stolniks, as Voivodes, and in many other positions and were granted fiefdoms.

2 - : Posterity of Prince Redega of Kasoga : the Great Prince of Tmutarakan, Mstislav, son of the Great Russian Prince Vladimir Sviatoslavich, the Christianizer of Russia, defeated the Prince of Kasoga, Redegia or Redega, and took to himself all his property and imposed on him a tribute. Children of Prince Redega, who after baptism were called Yurii and Roman, were servitors of the Great Prince. From Redega are descended many distinguished families, such as : Lopukhin, Kotovsky, Lupandin, and Ushakov. The great-grandson of Roman Radigich, Mikhailo Yuriev Sorokoum, had a son, Gleb, and from him is descended the Glebov family. Many descendants of this family served the Throne as Stolniks and in other distinguished positions and were granted fiefdoms.
