


Hernani



Description of Arms :

En campo de azur, tres lises, de oro, puestas dos y una. Bordura de gules.

Principal Title : Duke of Hernani.

Creation : Spain, 1914.

Subsidiary Titles : Duchess of Soria (1981), Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : S.A.R. dona Margarita de Borbon y Borbon, Infanta of Spain.

Family History : The *infante* don Manfredo de Borbón was the grandson of don Sebastian and doña Christina de Borbón. She was the sister of Queen Isabella II of Spain and her husband was the son of don Pedro.

The succession of this family is immensely complicated and is best followed on the family tree.

The title is currently in the possession of H.R.H. dona Margarita, who acquired the style by testament from Manfredo, who had become Duke of Hernani in 1914.
