

# Lichnowsky

*Description of Arms :*



**Principal Title :** Prince Lichnowsky.

**Creation :** Prussia, 1773.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Count.

**Family Name :** Lichnowsky.

**Family History :** Johann von Woschütz was the Supreme Judge of the High Court of Jaegendorf. As a result of a marriage, in 1491, he received the domaine of Lichten (Lichnow) and altered his name to Lichnowsky.

In 1727, they became Counts in Bohemia. Then the rank of Prince, 1773, and then Prince in Austria followed in 1843. Eleven years later, they were promoted to the rank of *Durchlaucht* - Serene Highness. Cadet branches are still addressed as Count.
