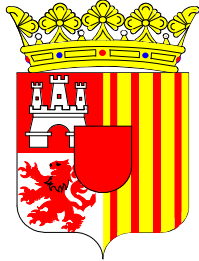


## Luna



### *Description of Arms :*

Escudo partido : 1º, en campo de gules, un castillo de plata, con un leon de gules, y 2º, en campo de oro, cuatro palos de gules. Brochante sobre el todo, un escuson de gules, con tres podaderas de plata, bien ordoenadas con el mango de oro, acompanadas de siete clavos de plata, dos en jefe, uno en abismo y cuatro en punta.

**Principal Title :** Duke of Luna.

**Creation :** Spain, 1495.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Grandee of Spain.

**Family Name :** Urzáiz y Azlor de Aragón.

**Family History :** King Juan II of Aragon had a natural son. Juan lived from 1397-1479 ; he was King of Navarre from 1425 and of Aragon from 1458, until the time of his death. In 1495, his offspring was made Duke of Luna and, later, Grandee of Spain. The title was created in favour of don Juan de Aragón, Count de Ribagorza and Vice-Roy of Naples.

Despite this age, the title is still in existence and was in the possession of the Duchess de Villahermosa until it passed to her second son.
