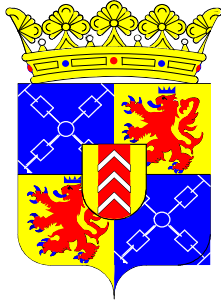


Luynes



Description of Arms :

Ecartelé: aux 1 et 3, d'azur à 4 chaines d'argent posées en sautoir et aboutissant en abisme à un anneau d'argent; aux 2 et 3, d'or au lion de gueules, armé, lampassé et couronné d'azur; sut le tout, d'or à 4 pals de gueules et 3 chevrons d'argent brochant sur le tout.

Principal Title : Duke of Luynes.

Creation : Duke of Luynes (1619), Duke and Hereditary Peer (1817), Duke of Chevreuse (1667).

Subsidiary Titles : Duke of Chevreuse. A junior branch of the family assumed, without investiture, the extinct title (which had been in the family) of Duke of Chaulnes (1621), Duke of Picquiny (1735), Marquis of Albert (1618). Prince of Neuchâtel and of Vallegin (1710), Count of Tours (1619) and of Dunois.

Family Name : d'Albert de Luynes.

Family History : Originally from the regions around Florence or Venice, the Alberti came to France in the XV Century.

In the person of Charles d'Albert (as the family was now called) rapid progress was made. Charles lived a comparatively short life (1577-1621). He started as Seigneur de Luynes and Captain of the Royal Hunt. In this latter capacity, he quickly became a favourite of Louis XIII. He became Marquis d'Albert in 1618, Count de Tours in 1619. The same year he reached the height of being Constable of France and Guardian of the Seals in 1621. He died, at the end of 1621, at the siege of Montheur.
