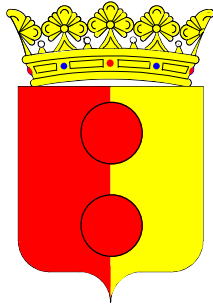


Montesquiou-Fezensac



Description of Arms :

Parti de gueules et d'or à 2 tourteaux de gueules. (l'un sur l'autre).

Principal Title : Duke of Fezensac, often listed as Duke of Montesquiou-Fezensac.

Creation : France, 1821.

Subsidiary Titles : Count of French Empire (1809), Peer (1819), Baron Peer (1824).

Family Name : de Montesquiou-Fezensac.

Family History : This is undoubtedly a very old family. In the male line, it can trace its descent to the old Counts of Fezensac; in the female line, it goes back to the Dukes of Gascony. In 1821, a dukedom was awarded, followed by letters-patent three years later.

The original line died out with the 3rd Duke in 1913 and many claim that it is now extinct. However, it was assumed *proprio motu* by another branch of the family and so continues.
