Description of Arms :

Troncato: nel 1° d'argento al leone uscente d'azzurro accompagnato da sei plinti di rosso coricati posti in fascia al ordinato in semicerchio; nel 2° d'azzurro a tre stelle d'oro disposte 2 e 1 (Dentice - Frasso)

Principal Title : (Duke of Accadia). Marquis of Accadia.

Creation : Title created in 1667, Naples. Title of Marquis was rehabilitated in 1967, Spain.

Subsidiary Titles : Prince of Arecco, Count of Santa Maria in Grisone.

Family Name : Dentice di Accadia.

Family History : This family represents the other branch of the X Century feudal family of Dentice. Originally from Amalfi, they were also associated with Naples and Sorrento as well as Salerno and Capua.

In 1733, from the hands of Charles VI, they received the title of Prince of Arecco. But, as a result of a marriage, they also acquired the title of Count di Santa Maria in Grisone, created in 1624, and Duke of Accadia, created in 1667. The marriage took place in 1695.

Strictly, the title of duke is extinct but that of marquis remains, though the majority of the family lives in Rome.
