En campo de oro, tres fajas, de gules.

Principal Title : Duchess of Andria

Creation : Spain, 1507.

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : De Bustos y Figueroa.

Family History : The title was awarded, a long time ago, in favour of don Gonzalo Fernandez de Córdoba; he was already Duke de Santangelo and de Sessa. The Cordoba family was hounoured, a few years later, with two of the original grandeeships of Spain.

However, the dukedom passed, not long afterwards in 1556 into the Carrafa family, who were Counts of Ruvo. And then, in 1904, it passed into the hands of the Bustos family, the head of which was the Viscount de Rias and which had connections with the Dukes of Pastrana.
