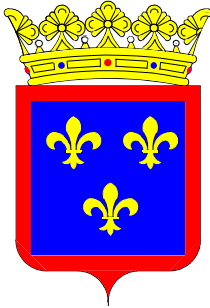


Ansola

Principal Title : Duchess of Ansola.

Creation : Spain, 1770/1886.

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : De Walford Hawkins y de Borbón.

Family History : This house stems from the royal family of Spain. The Infante Gabriel (1752-1788) married the Infanta Mariana-Victoria of Portugal. She, in turn, was the daughter of Maria I, Queen of Portugal and the Algarve. Their grandson, Pedro-Carlos, was raised to the rank of Infante of Portugal; he married Maria-Teresa (Princess of Beira), who was the daughter of John VI, King of Portugal..

Eventually we come to Luis, who was created Duke of Ansola. However, his elder brother, Francisco, had meanwhile been awarded the title of Duke of Marchena. The branch, founded by Luis, died out and inheritance passed to Juan-Jorge (John George) Walford y Borbon. He was the grandson of the 1st Duke of Marchena and he thus became 4th Duke of Ansola and 3rd Duke of Marchena. His eldest daughter, Maira-Cecilia, was recognised as Duchess of Ansola in 1981.

This family well illustrates the extreme complexity of many Spanish and Portuguese lines, which can pass through male (or failing which) female descent.
