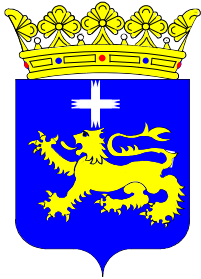


Ascoli



Description of Arms :

Index

Principal Title : Duke of Ascoli.

Creation : Charles II of Spain, 1679.

Subsidiary Titles : Prince of Sant'Angelo dei Lombardi (1718) and of Faggiano (1630).

Family Name : Marulli.

Family History : This family originally came from Greece but then settled in Monteleone in the Kingdom of Naples. In 1518, they acquired a clutch of baronies, including : Nusco, Andretta, Lioni, Carbonara, Monticchio, Oppido, Montemarano, Volturara and Parolisi. In 1679, real promotion came when Charles II of Spain awarded them the title of Duke d'Ascoli.

In 1813, as a result of a marriage to an heiress of the Imperiali family, the Marulli further acquired the titles of Prince de Sant'Angelo dei Lombardi (originally created by the Emperor Charles VI in 1718), Prince di Faggiano (created by Philip IV in 1630).
