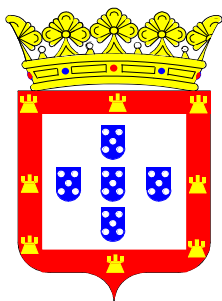


## Aveyro



### *Description of Arms :*

En campo de plata, cinco escudetes, de azur, puetos en cruz, cargado cada uno de cinco bezantes, de plata, puestos en aspa. Bordura de gules con ocho castillos, de oro.

**Principal Title :** Duke de Aveyro.

**Creation :** Portugal, 1547 and Spain, 1681 .

**Subsidiary Titles :** Marquis de Puerto Seguro (1629), Grandee of Spain.

**Family Name :** de Carvajal y Salas.

**Family History :** The origins of this family go back to royalty, to be precise, to natural children of King John II of Portugal. He ruled from 1481 to 1495, but he had no legitimate heirs and the throne then went on to his brother. The title was originally created, in Portugal, in 1547. It was recognised in favour of doña Maria Guadalupe de Lancaster. Then reconfirmed, in 1681, with the status of Grandee of Spain. It may be worth mentioning that, although this was not one of the original appointments as grandee, made in 1520, it was one of the first two thereafter recognised.

In 1715, the title passed in to the great house of Ponce de Leon, in the person of the then Duke of Arcos.
