Principal Title : Prince and Marquis of Canneto.

Creation : Charles VI, as King of Naples, 1732.

Subsidiary Titles : Marquis of San Lauro (1670).

Family Name : Gironda.

Family History : In fact, this family is of French origin. It went to Naples, in the train of Charles I of Anjou and, from 1450, it was established in Bari.

In 1625, the title of Marquis of Canneto was awarded by Philip IV of Spain to the family now known as Gironda. This was followed, in 1732, by the title of Prince di Canneto; this time at the hands of Charles VI, acting in his capacity as King of Naples.

In the XVIII Century, they further inherited, as a result of a marriage into the Giulielmini family, the title of Marquis of San Lauro, which had been created in 1670, by Charles II of Spain.
