


Carpegna



Description of Arms :

Principal Title : Prince di Carpegna.

Creation : Papal States, 1685.

Subsidiary Titles : { Count of Carpegna, etc. } Duke of Montefeltro Urbino.

Family Name : Originally Falconieri Gabrielli, now Carpegna Falconieri Gabrielli.

Family History : The Emperor Otto awarded the family twenty-four castles in Romagna and Montefeltro. It is from the Montefeltro branch that the dukes of Urbino came.

From this family, also, came five cardinals and the Cardinal-Archbishop of Ravenna. In 1685 they were made, separately, princes of Scavolino and of the Holy Roman Empire. But, in 1747, the last Count of Carpegna lay dying and he had no male heirs. Instead he called on his grandson, the Marquis Antonio Gabrielli, to change his name and adopt his arms. This he did and it was his descendants who became princes. In 1865, as a result of an inheritance, they added the name of Falconieri; now they use all three.
