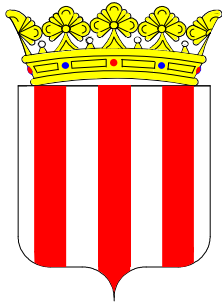


Caylus



Description of Arms :

For Robert de Lignerac de Caylus : D'argent aux 3 pals de gueules.

For Rougé : De gueules à la croix pattée d'argent.
D'azur à deux lions affrontés d'or, soutenant une flamme de même.

Principal Title : Duke of Caylus.

Creation : France, 1770.

Subsidiary Titles : Duke-Peer (1818), Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : Rougé.

Family History : At the end of the XIX Century, the House of Robert de Lignerac became extinct. The Spanish monarch then paid it the singular honour of creating a dukedom for a branch line, that of de Rougé, in 1893. This was confirmed by Royal Charter in 1914.

Thus title is now extinct.
