


Dalmatie

Principal Title : Duke of Dalmatie.

Creation : First French Empire. Original line died out in 1857.

Subsidiary Titles :

Family Name : Reille-Soult de Damaltie.

Family History : Nicolas Jean de Dieu Soult was born in 1768. After a spell in the Revolutionary Army, where he reached the rank of general, he took the side of Napoleon during the Consulate. He was raised to the rank of *Maréchal* and General of the Imperial Guard in 1804.

With the restoration of the Bourbons, he rallied to the king and was made Minister of War. However, he sided again with Napoleon during the Hundred Days. For this, he was banished under the Second Restoration. In 1819, he returned to grace. Under the July Monarchy, he became President of the Council (Prime Minister) on several occasions

He has become a Count of the Empire in 1808 and an Hereditary Peer in 1819. In 1847, he was created *Maréchal-Général de France*, as a personal reward for his distinguished services. At some point it is noted that he became Duke of Dalmatie, though at whose hand is not entirely clear.

A branch of the family of Reille took the added name of Soult, as a result of a marriage with Genevieve de Soult. This was homologued by the Tribunal de Seine in 1911, whereupon they also appropriated the duchy.
