


Gundorov



Description of Arms :

Quartely of six : 1 and 6, azure, issuant from a mount an oak tree, proper ; 2, Or an eagle reguardant volant, its wings elevated, sable ; 3 and 4, gules, issuant from the sinister edge an arm embowed, vambraced, invellped, and holding in bend sinister a sword, proper ; 5, Or, on a cloud on the lower edge an angel, its dexter arm counter-embowed holding in bend a sword , proper. Surtout an inescutcheon argent, on a mount proper "an irritated bear sable, who is tearing apart a nest of ants at the sinister base of an oak tree" (sic) proper.

Family History : This family is descended from the Princes of Starodub. The descendant of the Great Prince Vladimir Sviatoslavich, the Christianizer of Russia, Prince Ivan Vsevolodovich, received from his brother, the Great Prince Yaroslav Vsevolodovich, Starodub as an appanage in 1238, and from this there originated the Princes of Starodub. The great-great-grandson of Great Prince Ivan Vsevolodovich, Prince Andrei Fedorovich, had a great-grandson, Prince Ivan Fedorovich Gundor, whose descendants, the Princes Gundorov, served the Russian Throne in various positions and were granted fiedoms together with other tokens of the favor of the Monarchs.
