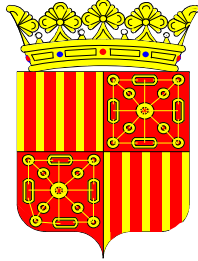


Hijar



Description of Arms:

Cuartelado : 1º y 4º, en campo de oro, cuatro palos, de gules, y 2º y 3º, en campo de gules, una cadane, de oro, puesta en orla, aspa y cruz.

Principal Title : Duke de Hijar.

Creation : Spain, 1483.

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : Fitz James Stuart y Silva.

Family History : This title was created, in 1834, in favour of don José Rebolledo de Palafox y Melzi. In the first instance this was a personal title (for life). However, in 1848, it was changed to being on an hereditary basis and the honour of being a Grandee of Spain was added.

It is now borne by the Duchess of Alba q.v.
