The title of Duke of Huescar was first awarded in 1563. It was awarded again, as a fresh creation, in 1871 to don Carlos Maria Fitz-James Stuart y Pontecarrero. This is the same family as that from which the Duchess of Alba and several other distinguished Spaniards come.
