Principal Title : Duke of Huete.

Creation : Originally in 1474.

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : de Bustos y Donate.

Family History : The original grant of this title is, by any standard, one of the oldest in Europe. It was created in favour of don Lopez Vásquez de Acuña y Carillo de Albornoz, Count of Viana. The Acuña family was particularly prominent at around that time. Two of the original twenty-five Grantees, elevated by Charles Quint in 1520, came from its ranks - the Count of Ureña and the Duke d'Esaclona.

It was rehabilitated, with the rank of Grandee, in 1909.
