Principal Title : Duke of Laurino.

Creation : Italy, by marriage (1891).

Subsidiary Titles :

Family Name : Caracciolo Rossi.

Family History : In 1891, the then Duke of San Vito married donna Ottavia Spinelli di Aquara, the 7th Duchess of Laurino and Marchioness of San Marco dei Gavoti and the various titles passed into the Caracciolo Rossi family. The duchy of San Vito goes back to 1645.

As with members of this illustrious family, the appellation of *don* and *donna* applies.
