Principal Title : Duke of Lecera.

Creation : Spain, 1493.

Subsidiary Titles : Count of Salinas (1470) and of Agrela (1890), Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : de Silva y Mora.

Family History : This title goes back to the Hajar family and that of the Royal House of Aragon. Don Juan Fernández de Hajar, Duke de Hajar and Count de Aliaga, was created Duke de Lecera in 1493. The rank of Grandee of Spain followed in 1599.

The title was recently restored.
