Principal Title : Duke Loubat.

Creation : Pontifical, 1893.

Subsidiary Titles : Count (1888).

Family Name : Loubat.

Family History : Extinct, 1927.

This family came from France. In 1891 and 1893, the coat-of-arms was authorised by Pontifical Letters. They had already become Counts in 1888 and, in 1893, the rank was raised to that of a duke, in favour of Joseph-Florimont Loubat. He died in 1927 and the title died with him.
