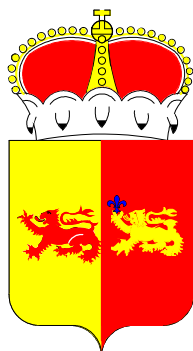


Lucedio



Description of Arms :

Principal Title : Marquis Carrega Bertolini, Prince of Lucedio.

Creation : Italy, 1877.

Subsidiary Titles : Marquis (1672).

Family Name : Carrega Bertolini.

Family History : This family identifies itself with Carrega, in the Piedmont. However, they were inscribed as patricians of Genoa in 1528. By 1672, they were raised to the rank of marquis. In 1849, Andrea Carrega married the Countess Giulia Bertolini and, with the permission of Grand Duke Leopold I of Tuscany, added her name to his. Not long afterwards, in 1877, they were made princes of Lucedio, on the basis of male primogeniture.

Interestingly, the habit of calling themselves Marquis seems to have endured, all branches so describe themselves, including the prince.
