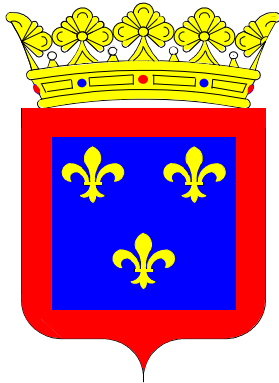


# Marchena

**Principal Title :** Duke de Marchena.

**Creation :** Spain, 1885.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Grandee of Spain.

**Family Name :** Walford de Borbón.

**Family History :** The Infante Francis was a descendant of Carlos III of Spain, who was King of the Two Sicilies and then of Spain, 1759-1788. He was also the son of Philip V and therefore the second of the Bourbon dynasty.

In 1927, it was confirmed that succession was transmissible to his daughter. The present holder of the title was born Maria Christina de Borbón but was adopted by Sir Basil Zaharof. In due course, she married Leopold Walford but, of course, retained her rights to bear the title. On her death, the duchy passed to her son, the present holder.
