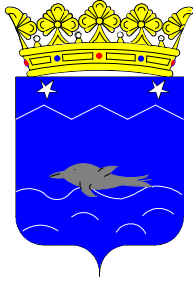


Maresca

Principal Title : Duke Maresca Donnorso Correale Revertera.

Family Name : Maresca Donnorso Correale Revertera.

Family History : The distinguished feudal family of Maresca has been prominent in Southern Italy, since the time of the Anjou rulers.

They first added the name of Donnorso to their own, some considerable time ago; the addition of Correale came in 1904 and that of Revertera in 1926. The elevation to the rank of duke - with the added title of Duke of Serracapriola - came in 1729 ; the style of count of the Holy Roman Empire in 1759 and various other titles also were acquired.

From the Revertera family, by inheritance, came the duchy della Salandra and others. The Emperor Charles VI awarded the style of Grandee, 1st Class, of Spain to this latter title. That was in 1718. The right to bear and transmit all the above was recognised by letters-patent in 1925.
