Principal Title : Duke of Marmier.

Subsidiary Titles : Baron of Longwy (1528), Marquis of Marmier (1740), Count of French Empire (1810), Peer (1815), Marquis (1820).

Family History : Extinct (1947).

In 1740, the land of Seveux was raised to the rank of a marquisate by Letters-Patent. Philippe-Gabriel (1783-1845) became the first Duke de Marmier. His wife was the daughter of the last Duke de Choiseul. He obtained authorisation to transmit the duchy of Marmier to his son-in-law. This substitution was confirmed by Letters-Patent, in 1818, and again in 1839.

However, the line died with Etienne, the 4th Duke, in 1947.
