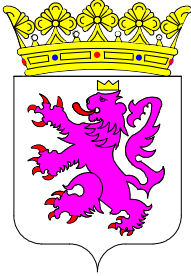


# Miranda



## *Description of Arms:*

En campo de plata, un leon rampante, de purpura, coronado de oro, unado y linguado, de gules.

**Principal Title :** Duke of Miranda.

**Creation :** Naples, 1664.

**Subsidiary Titles :** Viscount of Villanova, Grandee of Spain.

**Family Name :** de Silva y Azlor de Aragón.

**Family History :** This title was created in favour of a member of the great Caracciolo family (q.v.). It was granted in favour of don Francesco Caracciolo, in 1664, and was followed, the next year, with honour of Grandee of Spain. However, this latter was on a personal basis and it was not made hereditary until 1917.

The title was re-established at the same time in favour of don Luis Maria de Silva y Carajal.
