Principal Title : Duke of Montalto.

Creation : Spain, 1507.

Subsidiary Titles : Grandee of Spain.

Family Name : Bustos y Martorell.

Family History : This title was created in favour of don Fernández de Córdoba, Duke de Sessa and known as the "Great Captain". The Córdoba family, one of the greatest that Spain has produced, provided two of the twenty-five original Grandees, when Charles Quint introduced this distinction in 1520.

The title was confirmed in favour of don Fernando Bustos y Ruiz de Arana in 1919 and his son is the present holder.
