Family History : This is a family of Greek origin, which first came to prominence in Trebizond at the end of the XVII Century. From there it moved to what was then known as the Phanar - the Greek quarter of Constantinople. It is from the same source that the Phanar Princes Ypsilanti and the Moldave boyards Iamandi come. The Mourousi family provided two reigning voivodes in the principalities during the XVIII Century.

In 1855 and again in 1893, the right to the title "prince" was recognised in Russia.

The Greek branch was since died out but, of the remaining lines, two exist. One is known as the Russian branch, the other as the Roumanian branch.
